Notes of Interest from the Town Clerk's Office

Land Records- There were 1,487 documents recorded in 2006 totaling 4,741 pages. This filled eight land record volumes. This is an increase of 300 pages from 2005.

Dogs- 541 dogs were licensed by the April 1st due date. Our usual May reminder letter resulted in an additional 240 licenses being issued, for a total of 781 licensed dogs. This is a decrease of 39 licensed dogs from 2005. Not only is licensing your dog the law, but a licensed dog stands a much better chance of being returned to its owner should it wander off.

Records Preservation- Now that Birth, Death, and Marriage records have been encapsulated in Mylar, microfilming of land record volumes has begun again.

Cemetery Records- Started in 2005, computerizing the 8,000 "residents" of the Lyndon Center Cemetery will continue as time allows.

Elections- There are no State or Federal elections in an odd numbered year, but maintaining the voter checklist (now the Statewide Checklist) continues to be an important priority.
