Notes of Interest from the Town Clerk's Office

Land Records- There were 1,255 documents recorded in 2007 totaling 3,498 pages, which filled six land record volumes. This is a decrease of 1,243 pages from 2006. This decrease is due to rising interest rates and a changing real estate market.

Dogs- 557 dogs were licensed by the April 1st due date. Our usual May reminder letter resulted in an additional 210 licenses being issued, for a total of 767 licensed dogs. This is a decrease of 14 licenses dogs from 2006. Not only is licensing your dog the law, but a licensed dog stands a much better chance of being returned to its owner should it wander off.

Records Preservation- The process of preserving property transfer tax returns has begun. This process will entail the copying of each return onto preservation paper and filing the preserved copies into permanent volumes. This project will be undertaken as time allows.

Cemetery- The process of computerizing the 8,000 "residents" of the Lyndon Center Cemetery, started in 2005, has been picked up again and will continue as time allows.

Elections- 2008 is an election year. The Presidential Primary will be held on Town Meeting Day. The State Primary will be on September 9th, and the General Election will be held on November 4th.
