Notes of Interest from the Town Clerks Office

LAND RECORDS- There were 1,002 documents recorded in 2011 totalling 2,982 pages and filling five land record volumes. This was a 99 page decrease from 2010 recordings.

DOGS- 440 dogs were licensed by the April 1 due date. Our usual May reminder letter resulted in an additional 220 licenses being issued, for a total of 660 licensed dogs. For the sixth year in a row, this total is down. Not only is licensing your dog the law, a licensed dog stands a much better chance of being returned to its guardian should the dog wander off.

PRESERVATION OF RECORDS- A source for record microfilming continues to be sought.

The Town is required to use the \$4 per page of recording fee for preservation of records.

The Town set aside \$11,631 of the money collected in 2011 to be used for future preservation projects, possibly the digitalization of the land records.
