Notes of Interest from the Town Clerk's Office

LAND RECORDS-There were 1053 documents recorded totalling 3343 pages. This filled almost six land record volumes. Recording for 2012 was up from 2011 mostly due to refinancing because of low interest rates.

PRESERVATION OF RECORDS - A source for microfilming continues to be sought The town is required to use the \$4 per page of recording fee for preservation of records. The town set aside \$13,160 of the money collected in 2012.

DOGS - 454 dogs were licensed by the April 1 due date. Our usual May reminder letter resulted in an additional 265 licenses being issued, for a total of 719 licensed dogs. A census was conducted in the Fall and 126 letters were sent to those dog owners who had not licensed their dog(s). The letter informed them that should they fail to license their dog(s) by April 1, 2013 they would be subject to fines, penalties, which may include the surrendering of their dog(s).
