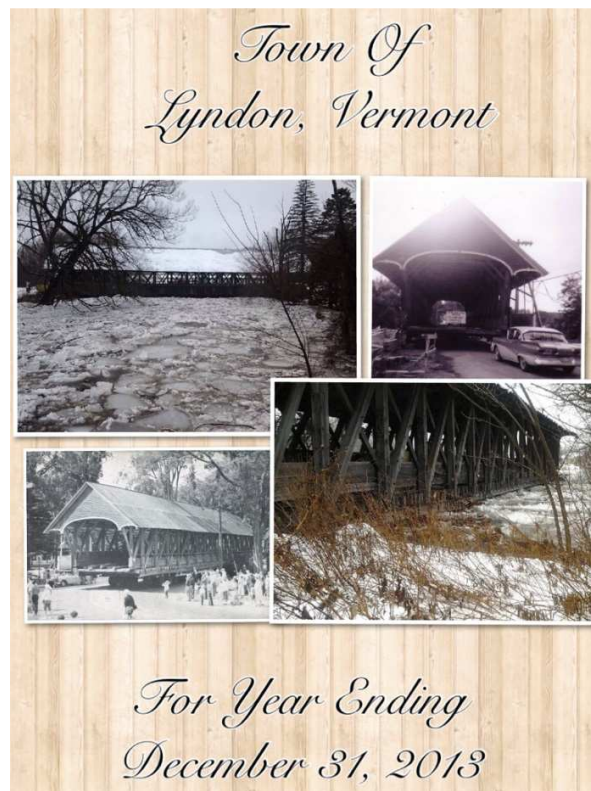

The Sanborn Bridge, currently located near the Lynburke Motel, was moved in 1960 from its original location on Center Street. In the fall of 2013 it was discovered that flood damage has caused the lower and upper chords on the downstream side to fail. The bridge was closed to walkers and snowmobiles for fear the bridge would collapse. The Covered Bridge Society has built a cribbing to support the sagging bridge.
