

**WARNING  
VILLAGE OF LYNDONVILLE  
ANNUAL VILLAGE MEETING**

The legal voters of the Village of Lyndonville, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet in the Municipal Office Building Conference Room at 119 Park Avenue, in said Village, Tuesday, March 18, 2014, at 7:00 PM for the following purposes:

**ARTICLE:**

1. To elect a Moderator and a Clerk.
2. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville authorize the Trustees to transfer the Restricted Funds identified as Miscellaneous (approximately \$33,700) to the General Fund for the purpose of reducing the deficit from 2013?
3. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote to adopt the proposed General Fund budget for the ensuing year?
4. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote that taxpayers pay Village real property taxes to the Treasurer on or before 4:30 PM on Friday, November 7, 2014, with delinquent taxes having interest charges of one percent per month for the first three (3) months, where after interest rates will be one and one-half percent per month, and an eight (8) percent late penalty charged against them from the due date of November 7, 2014, at 4:30 PM?
5. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote to authorize the Trustees to borrow money for the Electric Department not to exceed three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) in anticipation of revenues and to execute and deliver the note or notes therefore?
6. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote to authorize the Trustees to borrow money for the Water Department's normal expenses, not to exceed three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) in anticipation of revenues and to execute and deliver the note or notes therefore?
6. To elect the following officers as required: Treasurer; Trustee for remaining Four (4) years of a (5) Year term; Trustee for Five (5) Years; Delinquent Tax Collector; and Village Agent?
7. Do the voters of the Village of Lyndonville desire to transact any other proper business?
