ANNUAL VILLAGE MEETING


The legal voters of the Village of Lyndonville, Vermont, are hereby notified and warned to meet in the Municipal Office Building Conference Room at 119 Park Avenue, in said Village, Tuesday, March 20, 2018, at 7:00 PM for the following purposes:

ARTICLE:


1. To elect a Moderator and a Clerk.
2. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote to adopt the proposed General Fund budget for the ensuing year?
3. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote that taxpayers pay real property taxes to the Treasurer on or before 4:30 PM on Friday, November 2, 2018? (Delinquent taxes will be assessed a one-time late penalty of eight percent charged against them from the due date of November 2, 2018 at 4:30 PM. Interest charges of one percent per month will be charged for the first three months, starting December 1, 2018, whereafter interest rates will be one and one-half percent per month).
4. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote to authorize the Trustees to borrow money for the Electric Department not to exceed three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) in anticipation of revenues and to execute and deliver the note or notes therefore?
5. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville vote to authorize the Trustees to borrow money for the Water Department's normal expenses, not to exceed three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) in anticipation of revenues and to execute and deliver the note or notes therefore?
6. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville authorize the Trustees to eliminate the position of Delinquent Tax Collector and appoint the Treasurer as Delinquent Tax Collector?
7. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville authorize the Trustees to transfer the Restricted Funds identified as "Paving Class 1" (approximately \$46,534.41) to a Restricted Fund identified as "Paving Savings"?
8. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville authorize the Trustees to transfer the Restricted Funds identified as "Paving Class 3" (approximately \$32,642.95) to a Restricted Fund identified as "Paving Savings"?
9. Shall the voters of the Village of Lyndonville authorize the Trustees to transfer the Restricted Funds identified as "Water" (approximately \$26,117.35) to the Restricted Fund identified as "Water Main Savings"?
10. To elect the following officers as required: Clerk, Treasurer, Trustee for Five (5) Years, Delinquent Tax Collector (should Article 6 be defeated) and Village Agent?

11. Do the voters of the Village of Lyndonville desire to transact any other proper business?




