PLANNING COMMISSION

There are 2 openings; one for a 2 year and one for a 1 year term. Meetings are held the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of each month at 7:00 PM. Primary responsibilities are to prepare and update the Town Plan, update the zoning by-laws and, in general, help to plan for the future land uses in Lyndon.

DEVELOPMENT REVIEW BOARD

There is one opening for a 2 year term. Meetings are held the 1st and 3rd Thursday of each month at 7:00 PM if there is pending business. Primary responsibilities are to review and administer the Town's bylaws when conditional use or site plan approval are required. Also responsible for hearing appeals of the Zoning Administrator's decisions.
