- 1. Ray Durocher called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.
- 2. <u>LED:</u>

Ken Mason briefly updated the Board on the Hydro project at the Vail Sub-station and reviewed a letter that he had prepared for Dick Lawrence regarding the value of the work that the work camp crew does for LED trimming power lines.

3. Minutes:

4. Approval and signing of orders:

6. Bandstand Park Request:

The Natural Resources Conservation District is proposing to hold their annual plant sale in the Park on Saturday May 7th, 2016 from 8:30-11:30 AM. They will not require electricity and they will pack out their own garbage. Randy Amadon made a motion to approve the request. Ron Aiken seconded, and the motion carried 4-0.

7. <u>Highway Mileage Certification:</u>

The Trustees signed their certification of highway miles for the State of Vermont.

8. <u>Dumpster Contract:</u>
