- 1. Ray Durocher called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.
- 2. Minutes:

February 15, 2016 Minutes. Randy Amadon made a motion to approve the February 15, 2016 minutes. Chris Hunter seconded, and the motion carried 4-0.

- 3. <u>Approval and signing of orders:</u> The board approved and signed the Accounts Payable orders drawn on the Treasurer for weeks 7-11.
- 4. Bandstand Park Request:
 - a. The White Market made a request to hold their annual Easter Egg Hunt in Bandstand Park on Saturday, March 26th. Ray Durocher made a motion to approve the request. Randy Amadon seconded, and the motion carried 4-0.
 - b. H.O.P.E. has made a request to hold their 3rd annual Color Run event using Bandstand Park as their central location for activities. The event will take place from 9AM-12PM on Saturday April 30th, 2016. A children's run will take place at the park, while the main event will encompass Stevens' Loop. Chief Harris made an additional request that Maple Street be closed during the event as a traffic safety measure. Ray Durocher made a motion to approve the Color Run event including the closure of Maple Street from 9AM-Noon on April 30th. Heather Bollman asked to add a condition that the park be cleaned of all trash immediately following the event. Ray Durocher accepted the condition to his original motion, and the motion carried 4-0.
 - c. The Burke Town School 8th grade, Lyndon Town School 8th Grade, and Rural Edge are proposing to use Bandstand Park on Friday, April 8th from 9:30AM-12:30 PM to paint and decal 100 gingerbread men cutouts and stencil facts about hunger and H.O.P.E's backpack program on them. The gingerbread men will be placed at area businesses until April 29th, 2016, they will then be collected and placed in the Park during the Color Run event on April 30th. Ray Durocher made a motion to approve the request with the condition that drop cloths and plastic be used to paint on and that all trash will be collected after the painting is complete on April 8th. The Gingerbread men will also be collected immediately following the Color Run event on April 30th, 2016. Randy Amadon seconded, and the motion carried 4-0.

5. <u>Schedule of Rates:</u> The Board signed the Schedule of Rates form for the Water Department. The Rates themselves were approved on February 3, 2016.

6. Other:

a. Kaela Gray had inquired about a Trustee sitting on a tree committee to help prioritize the location of tree plantings. Chris Hunter agreed to sit on the committee. His role will be to help prioritize which locations within the recently completed tree inventory would be the best locations to plant trees, if a grant were to be obtained or applied for.
