1. Approval of Minutes

Approval of the minutes of March 31st was tabled due to a lack of a quorum.

2. Approval and Signing of Orders

The Board approved and signed orders for weeks 15-16.

3. Water Rate Discussion

Several representatives of large water users were present to contest the restructuring of the water rates. They felt the new rates discriminated against the large users versus home owners. Discussion followed including comments from Ashley Lucht of the State Water Supply Division. The Board agreed to look at the new rate structure again in the fall to work toward making the system as fair as possible.

4. Bandstand Park Requests

Oralie moved to approve the use of Bandstand Park for a Sunrise Service for Easter on April 20th. Ray 2nded. Approved 4-0.

Oralie moved to approve the use of Bandstand Park for the annual Day of Prayer service on May 1st. Ron 2nded. Approved 4-0.

5. Annual Highway Financial Plan

The Board signed the annual Highway Financial Plan as prepared by VTrans.

6. Request to Use Municipal Building Parking Lot

The Board Okayed the use of the municipal building parking lot on August 23rd for the 20th annual meeting of the Passumpsic Valley Land Trust.

7. Rod Key Pavement

Dan presented an idea from the Public Works Dept. to remove the existing pavement from Rod Key and turn it into a gravel road. Both the Trustees and Selectboard want to wait until later in the spring to decide what kind of shape the existing pavement is in before making a decision.

8. Other

Oralie moved to appoint Dan as a Trustee of the Village retirement plan. Tim 2nded. Approved 4-0.

The Board Okayed the annual Easter Egg Hunt in Bandstand Park for April 19th.

Oralie made the motion that the Village of Lyndonville will be National Incident Management System (NIMS) compliant. Ron 2nded. Approved 4-0. Dan Hill has already completed the required course work and Ken Mason agreed to also take the course which will satisfy the immediate need.
