1. Approval of Minutes:

Motion made by Randy Amadon, seconded by Ron Aiken, to accept the May 14, 2015 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 5-0.

2. Approval and signing of orders:

The board approved and signed the orders drawn on the Treasurer for weeks 21-24.

3. Water Connection Request:

Motion made by Ray Durocher, seconded by Randy Amadon, to approve a water connection application for Brian Bona for his apartment building located at 154 Main Street. Motion carried 5-0.

4. Signatories for Village Accounts:

Motion made by Randy Amadon, seconded by Ron Aiken, to add Heather Bollman & Ron Aiken as signatories on the Village's interest checking account with Community National Bank. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion made by Randy Amadon, seconded by Ray Durocher, to add Heather Bollman & Ron Aiken as signatories on the Sanborn Fund Trust. Motion carried 5-0.

Motion made by Randy Amadon, seconded by Chris Hunter, to add Heather Bollman as a signatory on both of Lyndonville Electric Departments interest checking accounts with Community National Bank.

5. Tax Anticipation Note: Randy Amadon made a motion to accept the .67% bid on the line of credit for the Tax Anticipation Note from Community National Bank. Ray Durocher seconded and the motion carried 5-0.

6. Revenue Anticipation Note: Randy Amadon made a motion to accept the .67% bid on the line of credit for the Revenue Anticipation Note from Community National Bank. Ray Durocher seconded and the motion carried 5-0.

7. Other:

The Trustees signed Donna Edwards' Access Permit Application which was approved, but not signed at the last meeting.

The Trustees decided they were not comfortable removing the trees and bushes from Depot Street if they were living. They would like to see the cages repaired if possible and discussed the possibility of

removing them altogether. Justin Smith said he would look into the option with the Public Works Supervisor.

Justin Smith handed out the audit reports for the Trustees to review.

Ron Aiken noted an increase in the number of loose dogs in the park and also an increase in the trash. Mr. Smith said he would talk to the Public Works Supervisor and see if he had noticed an increase in the volume of trash in the park.
