- 1. <u>Approval of Minutes:</u> The Minutes June 10, 2015 & June 22, 2015 could not be approved due to the quorum requirements for approving them.
- 2. <u>Approval and signing of orders:</u> The board approved and signed the orders drawn on the Treasurer for weeks 27-28.
- 3. Quarterly Report:

Dawn Dwyer presented the Quarter Report to the Trustees. She noted that there did not appear to be any concerns with budget. She mentioned that the highway winter materials (Salt) budget was high due to the weather and noted that the winter payroll was high for class 1 & 3 for the same reason.

- 4. Bandstand Park Requests:

- 5. <u>Water Connection:</u>

It was noted that there was a specific location that was agreed to at the time of the donation.
