1. Ron Aiken called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.
2. Acting Chair for Meeting: Chris Hunter made a motion for Ron Aiken to serve as chairperson in the absence of Ray Durocher. Heather Bollman Seconded, and the motion carried 3-0-1 with Ron Aiken abstaining.
3. Minutes August 15th & 17th, 2016:
Chris Hunter made a motion to approve the August 15th minutes as written. Doug Conly seconded, and the motion carried 4-0. Chris Hunter made a motion to approve the August 17th minutes as written. Doug Conly seconded, and the motion carried 3-0.
4. Approval and signing of orders:
The board approved and signed the Accounts Payable orders drawn on the Treasurer for weeks 34-35.
5. Demonstrations on Depot and Broad Street:
Justin Smith presented a formal complaint from Janis Henderson regarding graphic images being displayed by a group of demonstrators on the corner of Broad and Depot Street who periodically show up to demonstrate. Mr. Smith stated that at this point he was not providing a complete answer to the complaint, but he felt it was important to go on record at the meeting to show that the Village was actively seeking answers to the questions that were asked. At this point in time it has been clearly established that the group may demonstrate as long as they are not impeding anybody's ability to pass by. Police Chief, Jack Harris is still actively seeking a legal opinion with regard to whether or not the Village has the ability to limit what is displayed on signs for images when a group demonstrates. The complaint specifically asked about the ability to limit graphic images. The Trustees have taken the complaint under advisement and will re-visit the topic once a legal opinion has been obtained.

7. Executive Session Personnel:
Motion made by Chris Hunter, seconded by Heather Bollman to enter executive session with the Municipal Administrator to discuss a personnel issue under the provisions of Title 1, Section 313(a) (2) of the Vermont Statutes. Motion carried 4-0. The Trustees entered executive session at 6:26 PM.

The Trustees exited the Executive Session at 7:30 PM. No action was taken.
