Tim Gaskin called the meeting to order at 6:00PM.

1. Approval of Minutes:

Ron Aiken made a motion to approve the June 16, 2014 minutes. Oralie Lefaiivre seconded, and the motion carried 3-0-1 with Ray Durocher abstaining.

Ray Durocher made a motion to approve the July, 21, 2014 minutes. Oralie Lefaiivre seconded, and the motion carried 4-0.

2. Approval And Signing of Orders:

The Board approved and signed the orders for weeks 31-36.

3. Set the Tax Rate:

Ron Aiken made a motion to set the Village General Fund Tax Rate at .6459. Oralie Lefaiivre seconded, and the motion carried 4-0.

4. Bandstand Park Request:

Sally Marra requested the use of Bandstand on Friday September 19, 2014 for a baby shower from 3-6 PM. There will not be a need for electricity. Oralie Lefaiivre made a motion to approve the request. Ray Durocher seconded, and the motion carried 4-0.

5. Other:

Oralie Lefaiivre mentioned that cars were parked on the green area between the sidewalk and street on the south side of Center Street heading east toward Broad Street beginning at South Street. Mr. Smith said that they would have to change the Village Ordinance and add "No Parking" signs before enforcement could take place.
