1. Approval of Minutes

2. Approval and Signing of Orders

3. Bandstand Park Request

6. Sign Request:

The sign project is part of Lyndon Institute's new "J" Term which are intensive three week courses which will take place in January. The intent of the request is to inform the public that pollutants enter the Passumpsic River Basin through our storm drains. Randy Amadon made a motion to approve the request for five signs near storm drains within the Village. Justin Smith will approve the size, color scheme, and locations prior to Mr. Williams finalizing the signs. Ron Aiken seconded, and the motion carried 5-0.

7. <u>Hazard Mitigation Action Committee:</u>

Ray Durocher agreed to serve on the Hazard Mitigation Action Committee on behalf of the Trustees. The meetings would need to be daytime meetings.

8. Other
